

ANXIETY AND SCHOOL AVOIDANCE IN YOUTH: SOLUTION FOCUSED INTERVENTIONS THAT PRODUCE RESULTS

In addition to her academic and teaching work at UMass Worcester and Framingham State Dr. Lutz provides direct clinical supervision, teaching and training to psychiatric residents and workshops for community based treatment organizations. She worked for 9 years as a consulting psychiatrist for a residential treatment center for adolescent girls suffering from addiction and co-occurring disorders integrating solution-focused approaches within their treatment setting.
